The [HYDRO 2025](#) International Conference and Exhibition will be held at the [Rum Warehouse, Titanic Hotel Liverpool](#) on the **28th - 30th October 2025** and will bring together the global seabed mapping community. The conference provides a platform for professionals, researchers, and students to share innovative research, technological advancements, and best practices in the field of hydrography and seabed mapping.

Experts from authorities, industry, service providers, and research institutions, will have the opportunity to discuss the latest advances in hydrography and its impact on marine surveying, navigation, maritime safety, environmental protection, and sustainable development.

The conference programme will feature sessions dealing with recent technological advances, arising hydrographic topics, technical and scientific sessions, keynote presentations, workshops, and networking opportunities, covering a wide range of hydrographic topics.

Author Instructions

Abstracts should include a title (up to 100 characters) and a 300-word synopsis which must be accompanied by a biography and head and shoulder photograph of each author, along with details of their role and organisation(s).

Abstracts must be submitted to event@ths-uki.org by **6th June 2025**.

All abstracts will be reviewed, and successful authors will be notified of their abstract acceptance by **1st August 2025**. On receipt of acceptance, authors must confirm their intent to present in person through the purchase of the relevant delegate ticket. Please note, **THS:UKI** will not be able to cover the cost of travel, accommodation, or subsistence.

Presentations will be selected on relevance to the seabed mapping community, originality, and quality. Please bear in mind that this is a learned technical conference. Abstracts and presentations which are purely product based or overtly commercial in nature will not be considered.

All authors will be expected to grant joint copyright of the presentations to **THS:UKI**. It is the responsibility of the author(s) to obtain copyright permission(s), as necessary, for material in both their abstracts and presentations.

We also invite abstracts for poster presentations.

In addition, we offer the opportunity to publish a corresponding conference paper (typically 2,000 -3,000 words) in *soundings*, the **THS:UKI** quarterly publication. If you wish to publish a conference paper, the final version must be submitted by **19th September 2025**.
